 Chopin's Nocturne in E flat major, op. 9, no. 2, was composed between 1830-1832, when Chopin was around 20 years old. He dedicated his op. 9 nocturnes, a set of 3, to Maria Pleyel, the wife of an acquaintance of Chopin's. Chopin was Maria's piano teacher, and he dedicated many of his works to students.

 No. 9 in B major is Chopin's only nocturne in a major key that ends on a minor key (in this case, B minor), although some performers, such as Arthur Rubinstein, end the piece on a B major chord instead.

Frederic Chopin was one of the most original and influential composers in history. Although he only lived 39 years, he wrote music that has thoroughly embedded itself in our culture. His melodies are often instantly familiar to us and show a profound lyric sense. Many qualities of Chopin's music are ideal for guitar transcription. He wrote pieces that are short with a manageable range. The textures are mostly single melody lines with harmonic accompaniment without the complex counterpoint that can be so difficult on the guitar. His music is often soft, intimate, subtle, and full of nuances of articulation, dynamics, and phrasing. These qualities transfer quite naturally to the guitar. While remaining asfaithful as possible to the composer's musical intentions, these pieces experienced some modification that is noted in the provided performance notes. Intermediatein difficulty, this book assumes the player has basic knowledge of the guitar and familiarity with either standard music notation or guitar tablature.
