AA #1451 Danielson Domains 1 and 4. Administrators who evaluate teachers must demonstrate a high rate of inter-rater reliability, and communicate evaluation outcomes in constructive and supportive ways. Administrators who evaluate teachers must also recognize and control for bias when conducting an evaluation and determining results. School districts in Illinois must provide professional development to administrators to strengthen these skills on a sustained basis.

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Coaching Pointers and Strategies: Danielson 's Domains 1 - 4. Component 1a: Demonstrating Knowledge of Content and Pedagogy. Identifying facts and basic concepts. Skills in analyzing the facts and concepts. Comparing them to one another. Identifying connections with other aspects of the discipline or others. Understands which concepts are central to a discipline and which are peripheral.

Coaching Strategies: Danielson 's Domains 1 - 4

Domains 1 and 4 represent the "behind the scenes" work of teaching; essential for accomplished practice but not visible in the classroom. This means that a teacher 's skill in these domains must be demonstrated through artifacts, planning documents for Domain 1 and artifacts reflecting a teacher 's professionalism for Domain 4.

Component 1C of Danielson's Framework explains the importance of objectives in instruction. Objectives show what a student will do or learn because of a particular lesson. Danielson (2007) says that instructional outcomes should be clearly stated in terms of student learning, challenging to the students' current level, and central to content while coordinating with other disciplines (pg 52).
